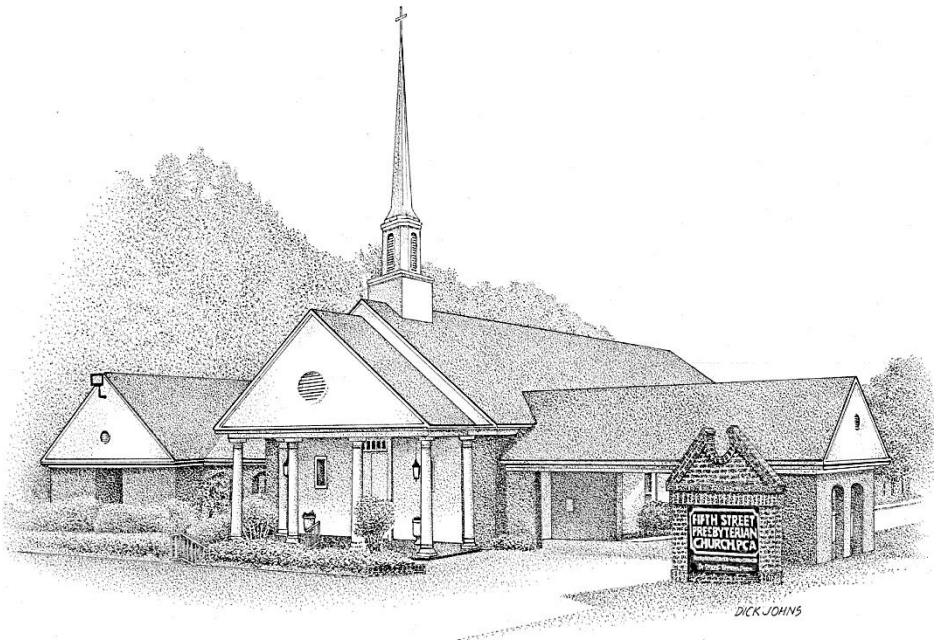


# Fifth Street Presbyterian Church
