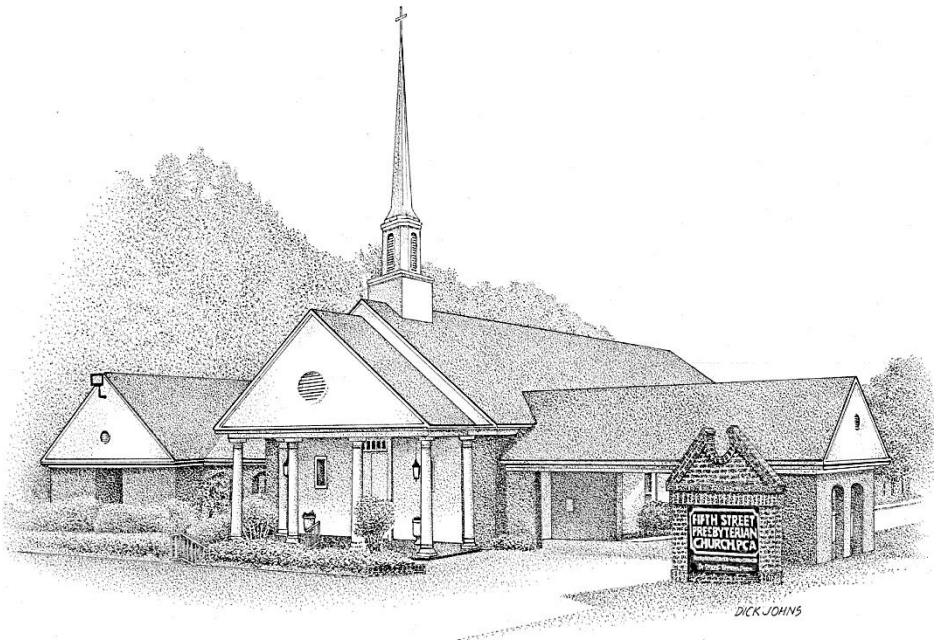

We warmly welcome Dr. C. N. "Nick" Willborn to our pulpit. Dr. Willborn is a Pastor of Covenant Presbyterian Church (PCA) in Oak Ridge, Tennessee, and Adjunct Professor of Historical Theology at Greenville Presbyterian Theological Seminary, where he taught full-time from 2000 to 2009. He holds a B.S. from Tennessee Technological University, an M.Div. from Mid-America Baptist Theological Seminary, and a Ph.D. in Historical Theology from Westminster Theological Seminary. Many will remember the conference he led at Fifth Street in 2021 on the lives and ministries of Martin Luther and John Calvin. Dr. Willborn will be with us Saturday through Wednesday, preaching and helping lead meetings.
