SERMON NOTES

Morning Sermon: Go and Sin No More—John 7:53-8:11

- I. The Woman Accused—that Christ might be charged (1-6b)
 - A. Having withdrawn from the city now returned to the Temple to teach.
 - B. The scribes and Pharisees brought a woman caught in Adultery.
 - C. A call for death...or to be more precise...a call for Jesus to call for death.
 - D. This they did to tempt Jesus.
 - E. This they did without compassion for the woman.
- II. The Accusers Accused—and found unworthy to Judge (6b-9)
 - A. Christ bent down and wrote with His finger.
 - B. Christ was silent.
 - C. Christ spoke.
 - D. The accusers left.
- III. The Accusation Withdrawn (10-11)
 - A. The condemnation left with those that accused her.
 - B. The condemnation was answered.

Evening Sermon: Prophecy Against Prophets—Ezekiel 13:1-16

- I. The Lying Prophets' Deception (1-7)
 - A. They pretended to understand what they did not understand.
 - B. They pretend to have a message from God.
 - C. They did not try to prevent the judgment of God.
 - D. They flattered the people into a vain hope that judgment would not come.
- II. The Lying Prophets' Destruction (8-16)
 - A. You lie—God is against you.
 - B. You lie—You will be cast out from Israel.
 - C. You lie—God will expose the cover up.
 - D. You lie—God will cause you to perish with your pathetic wall.
 - E. You lie—God will spend His wrath on you.
