SERMON NOTES

Morning Sermon: Deaf to Doctrine and Blind to Works— John 10:22-30

- I. Tell Us Plainly (22–24)
 - A. Don't keep us in suspense or cause doubt.
 - B. Tell us so we can understand; make us understand.
- II. I Told You, but You Don't Want to Believe (25–30)
 - A. Jesus said He has already proven His case.
 - B. They don't believe. Why don't they want to believe?
 - C. They cannot believe because they don't belong to Jesus.
- III. The Witness of the Father (29–30)
 - A. The Father cannot be overpowered, and we are in His care.
 - B. The Father gave them to Me, and He is greater than all.
 - C. I and My Father are one, so says Christ.
